Responsibilities

Partnership Development: Identify, cultivate, and maintain relationships with key partners, including NGOs, governmental bodies, academic institutions, and community organisations. Collaborate closely with partners to co-design and implement programmes tailored to address local needs and priorities.

Impact Evaluation and learning: Design and implement monitoring and evaluation frameworks to assess programme effectiveness, outcomes, and sustainability. Utilize impact data, identify areas for improvement, and champion evidence-based decision-making.

Advocacy and Communication: Advocate for causes supported by the Foundation, raising awareness and mobilizing support to increase the success rate of the activities. Integrate communication and advocacy as key components in programme design and implementation to ensure greater impact and disseminate learning and approaches.

Sector Innovation: Lead efforts to innovate within the philanthropic sector, leveraging learnings from programme implementation and impact evaluation. Explore new approaches, technologies, and partnerships to drive positive change and enhance the effectiveness and efficiency of philanthropic initiatives.

Systemic Change: Drive systemic change by identifying root causes of social issues and developing strategies to address them at a structural level. Advocate for policy changes, institutional reforms, and collaborative initiatives that promote long-term, sustainable solutions to societal challenges.
