The Government of Angola has received financing from the African Development Bank toward the cost of the **Coastal Towns Inclusive Sanitation Project Phase I**, and intends to apply part of the agreed amount for this loan to payments under the contract for **Procurement of Individual Consultant for the Senior Sanitation Expert (CO11-CTSIP1/24)**.

The Consultant shall provide technical advice and recommendations to the Client on all matters related to the design of all projects being implemented and supervised under the Project. Her/his role will include, amongst others, the following tasks;

- a) Write terms of references for studies in line with applicable guidelines of Angola and best international practices;
- b) Control and ensure quality of feasibility/technical studies, engineering designs proposed by Contractors/Consultants, according to applicable standards and regulations;
- c) Review and provide technical input on feasibility studies, engineering designs submitted by the Consultants and/or Contractors;
- d) Review and provide input on the deliverables of strategy for sustainable Sanitation services chain for operation and management;
- e) Ensure a smooth coordination amongst the different parts involved in the preparation and approvals of the engineering designs;
- f) Verify and advise on the needs for approvals of Government and Local authorities;
- g) Verify and propose the approval of any changes in the engineering designs during the project implementation;
- h) Participate in field technical verifications and supervisions;
- i) Provide input to quarterly project progress report and other reports required by the Government;
- j) Provide technical advice and support to DNA and project team on technical matters in the 11 coastal towns;
- k) Undertake capacity building activities through on the job trainings to young professionals;
- l) All the task assignment mentioned above are also equally applicable, as appropriate for the ongoing project of Institutional and Sustainability Support to Urban Water Supply and Sanitation Services Delivery (ISSUWSSD). The Consultant is also required to participate for the closing of the project.
- m) Assist the Project Manager and the Client on all technical matters; and
- n) Any other assignment related to the project as reasonably requested by the Client management.

The duration of the service will be **4 (four) Years** to be renewed annually upon satisfactory performance of the Consultant and mutual agreement.

The **Ministry of Energy and Water of Angola (MINEA)**, through the **National Directorate of Water (DNA)** now invites eligible **individual consultants** to indicate their interest in providing these services. Interested **individual consultants** must send a CV that provide information on their qualifications and experience demonstrating their ability to undertake this assignment (reference to similar services, experience in similar assignments, availability, etc.).

Required qualifications and evaluation criteria:

- a) Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering or Sanitary Engineering; post-graduate degree in Sanitary Engineering or related fields will be an added advantage; (10 Points).
- b) At least fifteen (15) years post qualification work experience in the field of wastewater and drainage, of which the specific experience for design of wastewater and sewerage systems should be at least 10 years; (20 Points).
- c) Work experience in Construction Supervision of at least three large urban water and sewerage projects (with significant component of wastewater) in a similar position; work experience of at least one project using FIDIC conditions of contract (procurement and monitoring) will be a plus; experience in providing capacity building to executing agencies professionals through on the job training will be an added advantage; (60 Points).
- d) Work experience in Sub-Saharan countries is required, work experience in Portuguese speaking countries, namely in Angola is an advantage; (5 Points).
- e) Fluent in Portuguese and working knowledge of English language. (5 Points).

Eligibility criteria, establishment of the short-list and the selection procedure shall be in accordance with the African Development Bank's Procurement Framework dated 2015 which is available on the Bank's website at <http://www.afdb.org>.
