

Water For People Expression of Interest (EOI): Global WASH Consultants – Project Design and Grant Writing

Water For People (WFP) is a global nonprofit working to develop lasting solutions to the water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH) challenges facing communities across Africa, Latin America, and South Asia. We are seeking to expand our roster of qualified consultants with deep technical and contextual knowledge in WASH to support our growing pipeline of institutional funding opportunities. Selected consultants will provide surge support during high-volume proposal periods. While interest will be accepted from consultants globally, consultants based in the following countries are preferred: Malawi, Uganda, Tanzania, Rwanda, India, Honduras, Bolivia, Peru, and Guatemala.

Consultants with expertise in designing projects and writing proposals related to WASH market systems development, nature-based solutions and climate resilience, fecal sludge management, results-based financing, infection prevention and control (IPC), and National/Subnational WASH Systems Strengthening are high priority areas of need.

This Expression of Interest (EOI) invites experienced **WASH consultants** to express their interest in providing **project design and/or grant writing services** in support of country-led proposals and regional or global initiatives. These services may include, but are not limited to:

- Complete a desk review of WFP's technical documents to understand our work.
- Participate in virtual project design meetings and to lead the technical design of WASH proposals, including needs assessments, logical frameworks, and implementation strategies.
- Facilitating co-creation workshops and concept development sessions with country teams.
- Supporting proposal reviews and editing in line with donor and organizational guidelines.

We are particularly interested in consultants with:

- Extensive experience writing high-quality narrative sections aligned with donor requirements (e.g., World Bank, GIZ, UNICEF and other UN agencies, African Development Bank, Gates Foundation, etc.).
- An understanding of developing monitoring and evaluation (M&E) plans and log frames in alignment with WFP's indicators.
- Proven experience developing successful proposals for bilateral and multilateral donors and Requests for Proposals (RFPs).
- Technical expertise in WASH systems strengthening, climate resilience, nature-based solutions, and/or WASH in fragile contexts.
- Excellent writing skills in English or bilingual Spanish-English is required.

- Strong collaboration and communication skills with cross-cultural and remote teams.
- Understanding of the following geographic contexts: East and Southern Africa, Central and South America, and South Asia are encouraged to apply.
