An employee in this temporary student position will function as a Technical Assistant. This position undertakes activities in support of various duties in support of groundwater management.

Duties and responsibilities may include (not limited to):

- Entry of groundwater data into a database system.
- Identify and report data discrepancies to ensure accuracy.
- Assist senior staff with operation, completion and maintenance of the Provincial groundwater observation well network, groundwater quality sampling, install telemetry equipment and other duties, as assigned.
- Support and participate in field activities, organizing, maintaining, and troubleshooting equipment.
- Provide assistance to miscellaneous duties, as assigned.
- Working safely and participating in workplace safety programs.

Qualifications and Requirements:

The ideal candidate must be enrolled in a post-secondary institute in one of the following programs: Geological Science, Physical Science, Data Management, Engineering, or a related discipline.

Work may require considerable travel, an irregular work schedule, extended absences from headquarters with overnight stays for up to one week. Travel, sustenance, and accommodation costs will be provided when required to work away from headquarters. Lifting and carrying up to 20kg, operating power, electronic equipment and tools will be required.

This role is subject to satisfactory criminal record check.
