- Assist with conducting field investigations and inspections, including assisting with the evaluation of environmental and topographic conditions.
- Provide technical assistance in performing various surveys in accordance with established engineering procedures and practices.
- Assist with preliminary construction and post construction surveys in accordance with established engineering procedures and practices.
- Assist with and/or perform relevant technical calculations in both the field and office.

- Assist with preparing applicable reports, technical documentation, and drawings; and
- Assist in undertaking maintenance/ operations of corporate equipment and facilities.
