Water First is a registered charity grounded in trust-building, meaningful relationships, and lasting impact. Our engagement is guided by responsibility and accountability, with Indigenous voices, experiences, worldviews, and inherent rights centred across all our work.

To ensure Indigenous perspectives lead discussions about work with Indigenous communities, we integrate consultation with Indigenous staff, the Indigenous Advisory Council, community partners, and Indigenous members of our Board of Directors.

We respect and value Indigenous cultural traditions and practices in our workplaces, including the burning of medicines such as tobacco, sage, cedar, and sweetgrass. All employees are expected to maintain strong Indigenous historical and cultural awareness and commit to ongoing learning to support respectful, informed approaches throughout the organization.

Under the direction of the Director of Programs, the Senior Manager of Drinking Water is responsible for leading the operational delivery of Water First's Drinking Water Internship program across active project teams. This role supervises and supports Project Managers, ensures consistency and quality across project implementation, monitors delivery risks and timelines, and supports strong collaboration with Indigenous community partners, operators, internal departments, and program staff.

The Senior Manager plays a key role in translating departmental priorities into coordinated project delivery, while escalating strategic, partnership, budget, staffing, or program model decisions to the Director of Programs.

Delivery Planning and Program Improvement

- Support the Director of Programs in implementing departmental priorities, annual plans, and growth decisions.
- Translate approved program priorities into operational plans for active Drinking Water Internship projects.
- Identify delivery challenges, risks, and opportunities for improvement across project teams.

Project Delivery Oversight

- Supervise, coach, and support Drinking Water Project Managers.
- Provide regular check-ins, performance feedback, work planning support, and escalation support to Project Managers.
- Oversee project-level milestones, timelines, work plans, staffing needs, and training delivery schedules across active DW Internship projects.

Finance and Administration

- Support the Director of Programs with annual planning, delivery forecasting, and budget inputs related to active Drinking Water projects.
- Oversee project-level budget tracking in collaboration with Project Managers and Finance.
- Monitor project spending, delivery assumptions, and resource needs, and escalate budget risks to the Director of Programs.

Raise organizational awareness
